Dear Parents

I would like to remind you about the importance of working together with our local school neighbours to ensure that Blessed Robert Widmerpool CVA has a positive impact on our local Clifton community.

Local Property

At Blessed Robert Widmerpool, we are proud of the relationships we have built over the years with our Clifton neighbours: those who live in houses next to the school as well as those neighbours who live on roads further away on the estate. Our neighbours consistently have positive things to say about the school, our pupils and their families.

Recently, we have been notified by members of the Clifton community about accidental damage to front garden property caused by pupils in our school community. We ask that parents and carers remain vigilant and encourage their children to walk to and from school respectfully and carefully. If accidents do occur, we ask that the home owners are notified so that our parent community can work with our neighbours to fix any damage.

Parking

As you are aware, it can be very busy on the roads outside school during drop off and pick up times. We therefore request that you adhere to the following when parking, dropping off or collecting children from school:

- Keep any 'Keep Clear' markings clear
- Ensure pavements, neighbours' driveways and pedestrian access points are kept clear
- Ensure emergency vehicles would be able to get past if needed
- Turn off your engine when parked
- Act in a manner than is respectful towards others – including fellow parents, guardians, pedestrians and local residents
- Park further away from school if at all possible - Corpus Christi Church Car Park is open and available for parents to park there in the morning, then walk round to school with their children
- Consider whether or not the car is necessary in drop off and collecting your child(ren) from school

Thank you for your cooperation. With your help, we hope to continue the strong and positive relationships the school has with its wider community.
