Wellies!

- 1) **OPAL is all weather!** This means that come rain or shine, we want our children to be playing outside as much as possible. We hope that wet-play will be very rare. In order to do this, our children need to be properly equipped. We would like **each child to have their own set of wellies in school**. If you are able to send in a pair of wellies for your child(ren) to be kept here, this will mean they can enjoy play no matter the weather. It might be that you are able to send them in with a second pair, or that they bring their one-and-only pair in each day/week. **From November 5th**, we will have some temporary wellie storage, so send your children in with wellies from that date!
- 2) **Storage:** Speaking of wellies, we need storage! We have plans for some temporary outdoor storage of all our children's wellies. But we will need some permanent storage in the long-term. If you or anyone you know have the building knowledge to create any structures on the following page, we would welcome your time. We will do our best to source the materials; all you would need to bring are the tools and the skills!
